


# Expected vision outcomes with main lens types used for cataract and refractive lens exchange

Lens Type	Expect vision outcomes			Things to note
	<b>Distance</b> (e.g., Driving, watching a film at the cinema, etc.)	<b>Intermediate</b> (e.g., Using a computer, reading labels while shopping, etc.)	<b>Near</b> (e.g., Reading)	
Standard monofocal	✓	✗	✗	
Premium monofocal	✓	Maybe*	✗	*These lenses are not as strong as EDOF. So, some people will achieve intermediate vision, and others won't. However, they have a better range than standard monofocals.
Extended Depth of Focus (EDOF)	✓	✓	Maybe*	*These lenses are not as strong as Trifocal. So, some people will achieve good near vision overall but may need glasses for fine print reading.
Trifocal	✓	✓	✓	

All the above lenses also come in a toric version (if required) to treat any astigmatism as well
